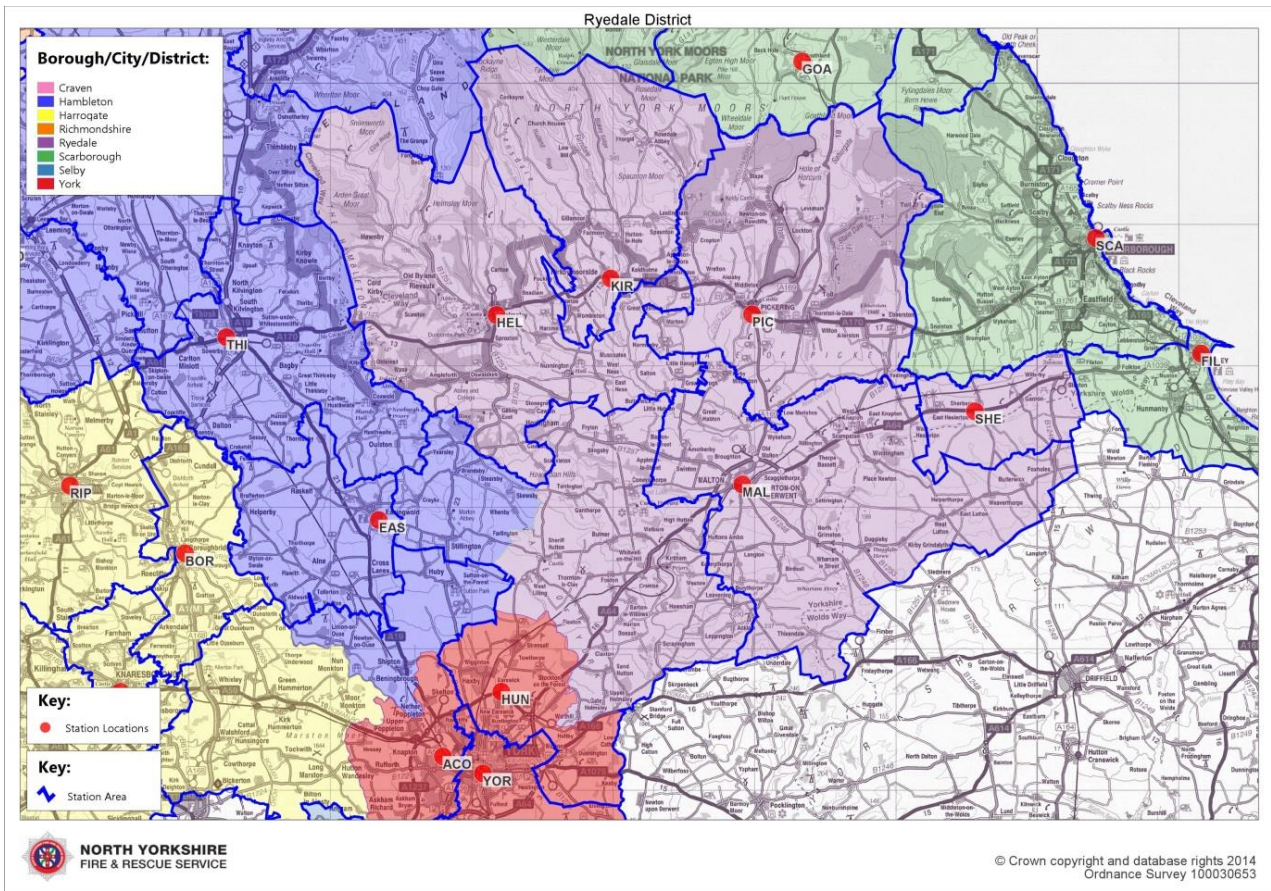

Ryedale District Fact Sheet

Introduction

In order to manage the day-to-day arrangements of the Service, we split it into Districts, which match the District, Borough and City of York council areas. For the Ryedale District, it is aligned to the Ryedale District Council area.

The population of Ryedale District Council Area is (2011 census) is 51,751. There are five fire stations in the District: Malton, Pickering, Helmsley, Kirkbymoorside, and Sherburn.

















The current resources and proposed changes are set out below.

Incidents

During 2014/15, we attended 336 incidents in the Ryedale District Council area. This is a decrease of 42% since 2010/11*

* Updated 13th August 2015. During the York Review which took place during 2014, some of the station area previously assigned to Malton was allocated to Huntington fire station when the crewing arrangements changed. As a result of the ongoing Fire Cover Review consultation, two parts of this area have now been re-allocated to Malton fire station to better reflect the Malton station area. The number of incidents for Malton has been updated.

RDS Availability

For 2014/15, the average availability of RDS stations across the Ryedale District Council area was 79.4% (this ranges from 72.2% to 88.4%).
